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

- student exchange program
- 28 member states of the E.U
- part of the European Higher Education Area

Erasmus:

Adopted in **1987**

85 million ECU (=€85million) for the period **1987-1989**

3 million student have benefited from it between **1987** and **2013**

At the begining: 11 countries





- ECTS : 60
- = 1500 and 1800 course hours
- In theory good but not in practice
- EU : 1998 area promoting the mobility of students
- Bologna process : bachelor, master, doctorate
- 48 european countries

- To travel to study anywhere in europe
- Europass : CVs, language, passports, diplomas, ect..
