

1) How does the inheritance and wealth tax works in France ?

Tax applied on the transfer of an inheritance that is due to the heirs of the deceased person.

Abatement : inheritance tax is not due up to a certain amount.

- ❖ Children : 100 000€
- ❖ Spouse : 80 724€
- ❖ Siblings : 15 923€
- ❖ Non-heir : 1 594€



No will

❖ Not married : 4 orders

1) children

2) parents, brothers and sisters

3) grandparents

4) uncle, aunt, cousins

❖ Married



A will = decide who inherits

- ❖ France = not possible to disinherit children or spouse.
- ❖ France = compulsory to consult notary when estate > 5 000€, include real estate, a will or donation.
