



EUROPEAN COMMISSION

- Politically independent executive arm
- Headed by Ursula von der Leyen
- Composed of 27 European Union Member
- "Guardian of the treaties"

Fine of 395 million euros



THE EUROPEAN COURT OF JUSTICE

Two jurisdictions :

- 1) The court of justice with 1 judge from each country and 11 advocates general
- 2) The General Court with 2 judges from each country



Located at Luxembourg





EUROPEAN CONVENTION ON HUMAN RIGHTS

- First convention of the Europe Council
- Adopted in 1950
- Entered into force in 1953
- Ratification indispensable condition for accession to the Organization
- Protects the rights of more than 700 million people in Europe



THE IMPORTANCE OF RESPECTING EUROPEAN LAWS

PEOPLE UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE "**

THE EU**


