- 1952 – Creation of the European Coal and Steel Community (ECSC)
- March 25, 1957 – Signature of Rome's Treaties
 - 6 countries : West Germany, Belgium, France, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands
 - Creation of Euratom and the European Economic Community (EEC)
- Euratom means "European Atomic Energy Community" (EAEC)

KEY POINTS OF THE NEGOCIATION

Nationalization of the Suez Canal by Gamal Abdel Nasser

- Threat for oil supplies in Europe

26 July 1956

25 Mar. 1957

Creation of European Common Market (at the same time as Euratom)

- Allowing to satisfy everyone

To ensure the supply of minerals and nuclear fuels (Euratom Supply Agency)

To implement security norms for workers

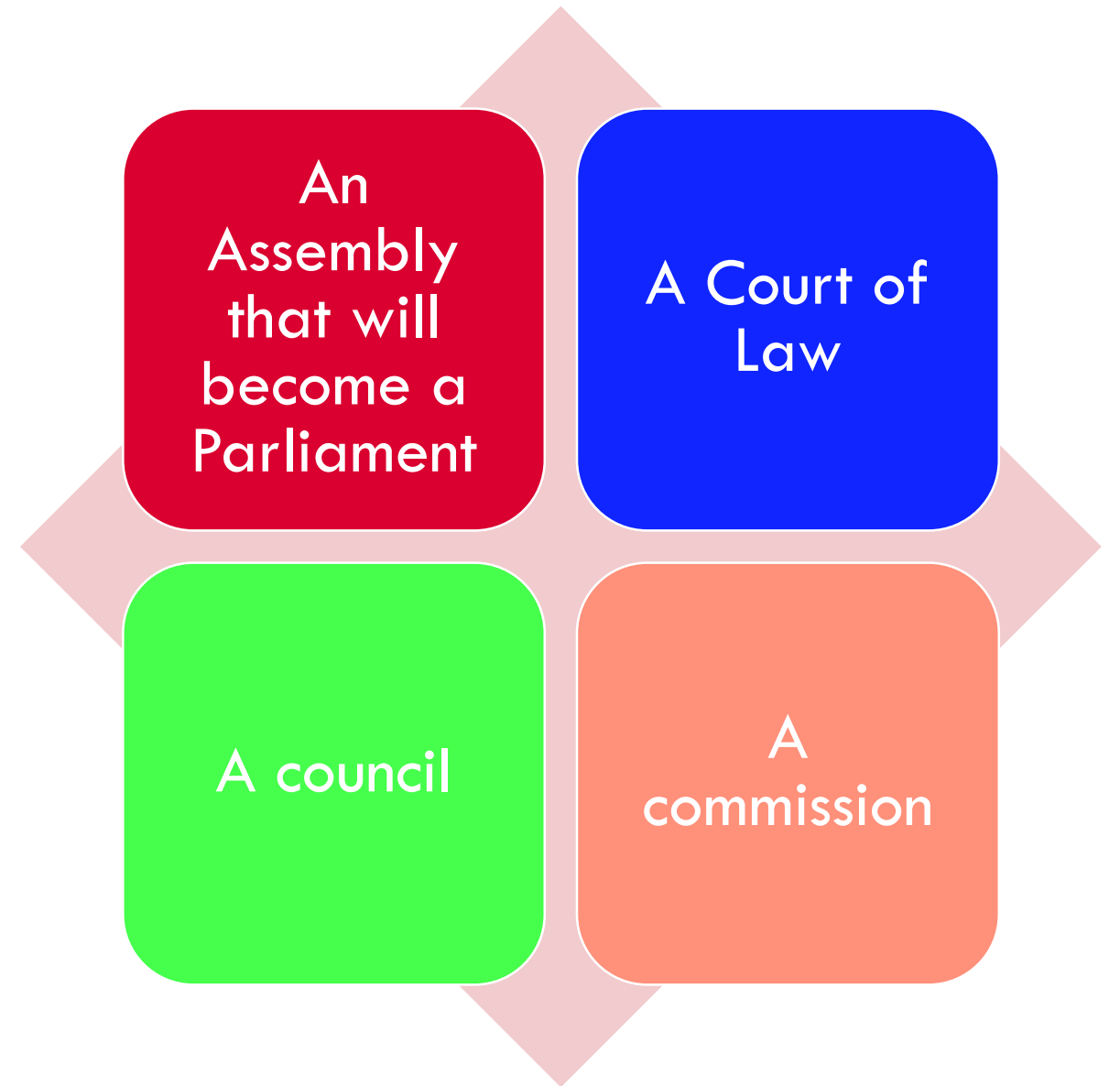
To develop a strictly peaceful use of nuclear energy
