AlphaGo



- AlphaGo is a computer program that plays the board game Go. It was developed by DeepMind Technologies.
- Monte Carlo tree search algorithm
=>an artificial neural network
- In October 2015, the original AlphaGo became the first computer Go program to beat a human professional Go player (FAN Hui).
