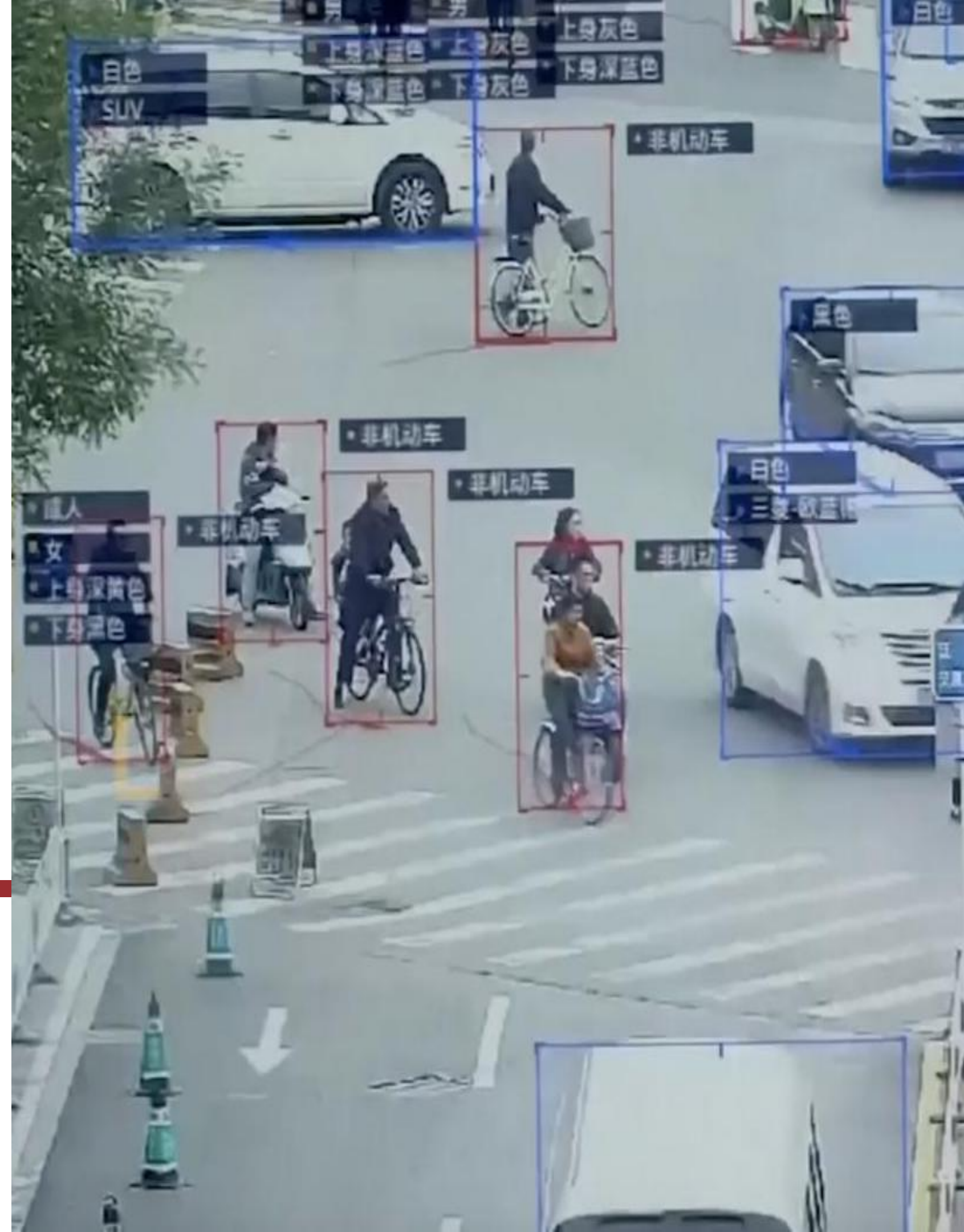

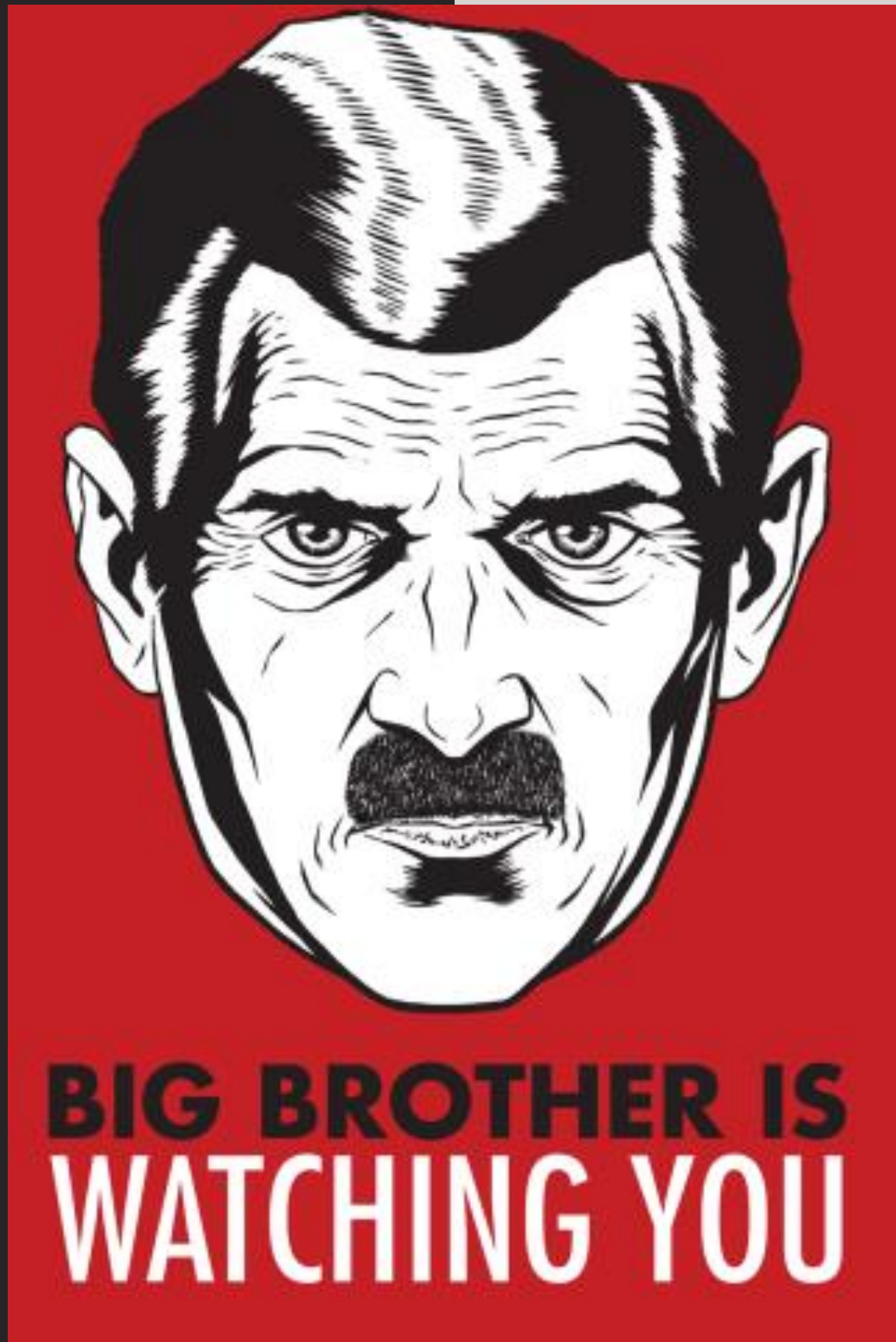

HISTORY

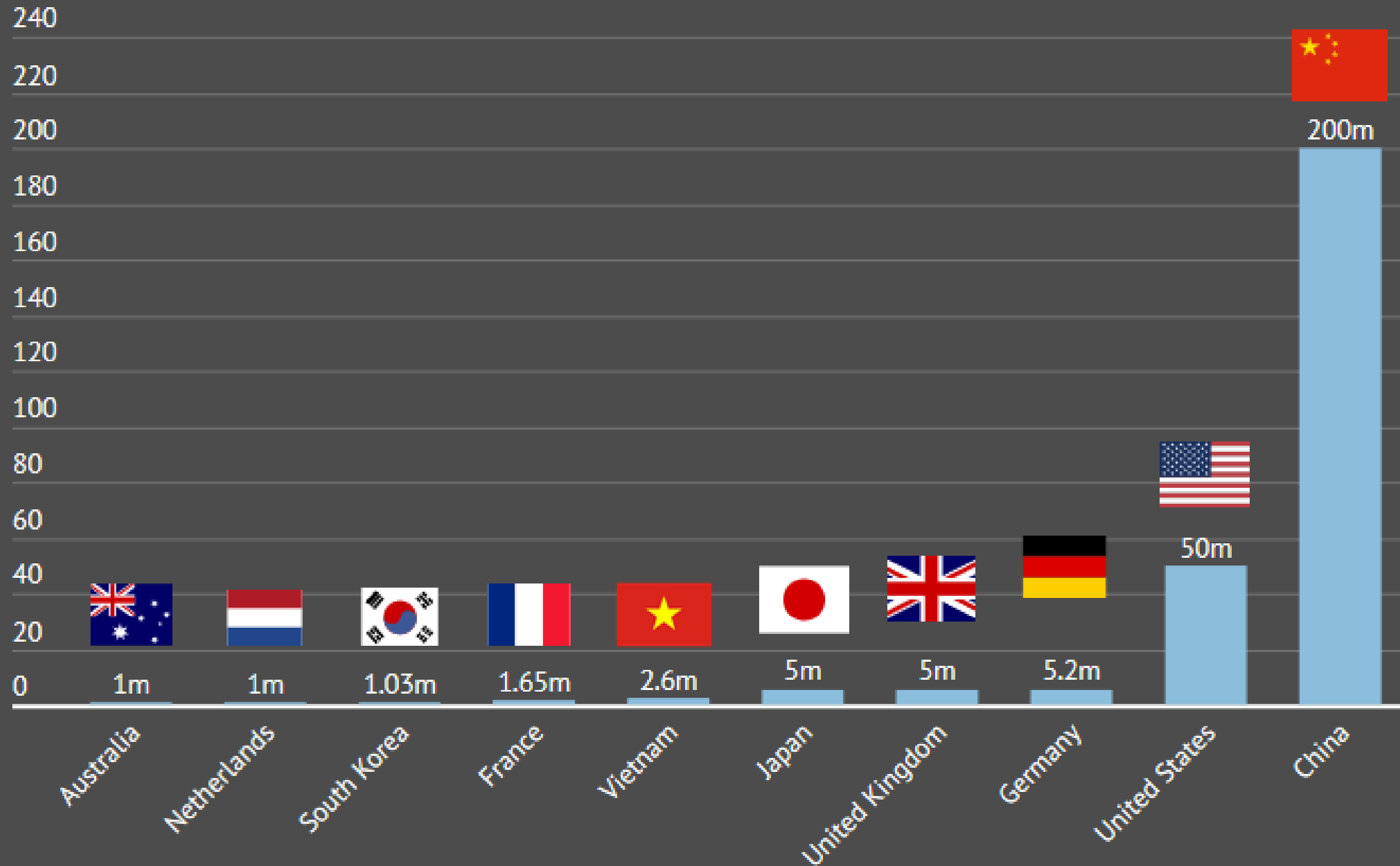
Big brother is a term that first appeared in 1949 in George Orwell's novel 1984

"Social Credit" system

- permanent monitoring with facial recognition cameras & Big Data
- monitoring combined with a rating system



Law on the purchase of a phone

- be registered by facial recognition
- accept that its personal data is kept



Monitoring application

- collect a large amount of data
- receive a visit in case of suspicious behaviour
