THE BIRTH OF THE COLD WAR :1947-1950


- Official start of the Cold War in 1947
- Marshall Plan: financial aid to counter Communism in Europe
- Division of Europe: Eastern Bloc (USSR) vs Western Bloc (USA)



THE MAJOR CRISES OF THE COLD WAR

-Berlin Blockade (1948-49): Intense tension between the USSR and the USA

-Berlin Wall (1961): Symbol of ideological separation

THE CUBAN MISSILE CRISIS : 1962

- USSR deploys missiles in Cuba, close to the United States
- US reaction: Kennedy imposes a naval blockade around Cuba
- Extreme tension: risk of nuclear war
- Agreement: USSR withdraws missiles, USA avoids Cuba invasion and removes Turkey missiles.
- Consequences: Crisis averted, but tensions between the superpowers heightened

REFORMS AND THE END OF THE COLD WAR : 1985-1991

- Gorbachev's reforms: Perestroika and Glasnost
- Fall of the Berlin Wall (1989): Symbolises the end of division
- Dissolution of the USSR (1991): End of the Cold War
