# Who they are?

- “Royal Dutch Shell is a British-Dutch multinational oil and gas company and (...) measured by 2020 revenues, the fifth largest company in the world, the largest based in Europe, and the largest not based in either USA or China”
- “Shell is a global group of energy and petrochemical companies that aims to meet the world’s growing need for more and cleaner energy solutions in ways that are economically, environmentally and socially responsible”.

- Around 43,000 service stations in more than 80 countries
  - Fuel, diesel, LNG, among others, are the main products of the firm



# Shell's lobbying

- € Costs on lobbying on the EU: 4,250,000€ - 4,499,999€ (against 4,963,382 € of grants from EU institutions)
  - € Along with the other lobby groups it is a member of, it has spent over €215 million since 2010
  - € 16 declared lobbyist / 3 lobbyist with EP accreditation
  - € In-house lobbying
  - € The declared amount is the best estimate of costs associated with interest representation activity.
  - € Shell has the third largest individual company spend on lobbying in Brussels (after Google and Microsoft)

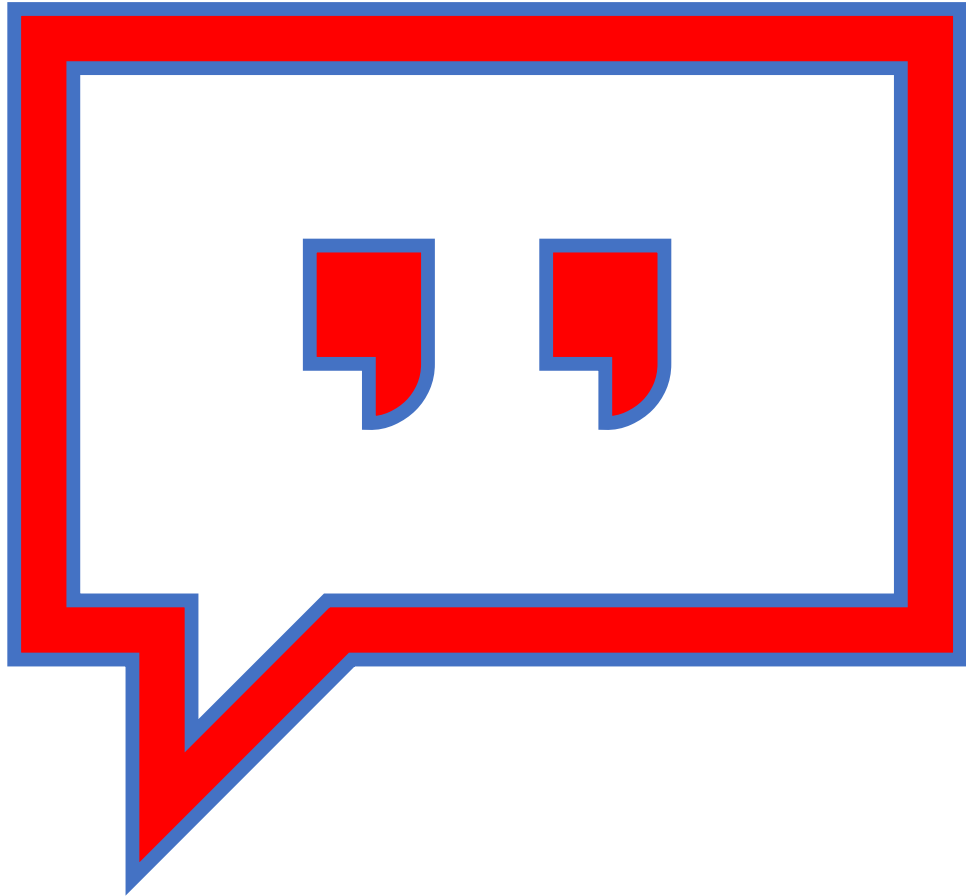
