# Value Added Tax (VAT)

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## What is VAT?

**VAT** is an indirect tax that is collected throughout a supply chain. That means suppliers, distributors, manufacturers, and retailers collect tax on all qualifying sales. VAT is controlled on a national level.






The United States does not have VAT but instead has a sales tax that varies from state to state.

**Sales Tax** is exclusively collected by a retailer during the final sale of a good or service and it is paid by the end consumer. It is only collected a single time, when the good or service is sold to someone for final use.

A certain tax rate of (0 to 12%) as added up to the selling price of a goods or services or properties as well as importation in the Philippines

- VATABLE 12% on gross selling price or gross value in money of the goods or properties sold bartered or exchange
- 2. VAT ZERO RATED (0%) export sale of service, foreign currency denominated sales or those zero-rated as approved by special laws (PEZA or economic zone registered companies)
- 3. VAT EXEMPT agricultural and marine Products, educational services, medical, dental, optical services

#### Who are Required to File VAT Returns?

- Any person or entity who, in the course of his trade or business, sells, barters, exchanges, leases goods or properties and renders services subject to VAT, if the aggregate amount of actual gross sales or receipts exceed Three Million Pesos (Php3,000,000.00) or (50,000 Euros)
- A person required to register as VAT taxpayer but failed to register
- Any person, whether or not made in the course of his trade or business, who imports goods

- General rate of 16%,
- Certain activities and products have a 0% VAT rate.
- The VAT rate applied to people that live in border cities is equivalent to a 8% VAT rate.



- The people that have to pay VAT are the people and companies that do any of the following activities within the Mexican territory:
  - Alienate goods
  - Provide independent services
  - Grant the temporary or permanent use of goods
  - Import goods or services.



- Some of the products that are charged with the 0% VAT rate include the following:
  - Alienation of not industrialized animals and vegetables.
  - Medicines
  - Fertilizers, plaguicides, herbicides, etc, that are meant to be used for agriculture.
  - Providing services to agricultural purposes
  - And the export of certain products as provided by the VAT laws in Mexico.

Aside from the both rates that are applied in Mexico, there are certain activities that are exe of a VAT rate, for instance, public transport.

#### Food

- All types of Healthcare and Insurance Services

**Education** (from nursery to PHD)

#### **Transportation**

Public Transportation (Buses, Trains, Trams)

**Houses/Condominiums/Apartments** (not for rental)





## **Higher VAT Rates**

#### Higher tax rates (20%) for the following:

- Alcoholic Beverages (Low Alcohol and Spirits)
- Tobacco
- Private cars, airplanes, yacht, boat
- Hotels, Motels, Rest Houses, Pension Houses, Inns, Resorts
- Night Clubs, Pubs, Bars and Casinos
