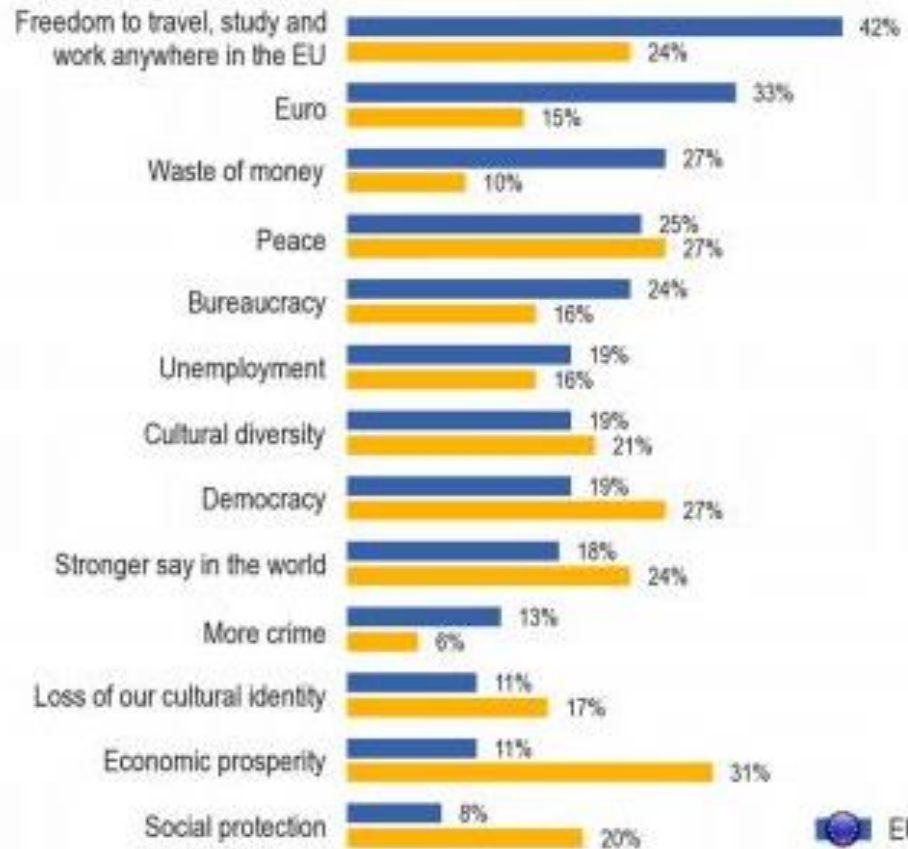
European membership:

- 38% in favour (+2 percentage point)
- 31% against (-2 pp)
- 21% neutral (+2 pp)
- 10% no opinion (-2 pp)

Turkey would benefit from being a member of the EU:

- 48%: YES (+8 pp)
- 37%: NO (-7 pp)
- 15%: DO NOT KNOW (-1 pp)

Nationalist Party in Turkey

- A far-right political party
- Ideology is Turkish nationalism
- Headed by Devlet Bahçeli
- 52 deputies, the third largest parliamentary group(9.4% in the Turkish Parliament)

 - Foreign Policy

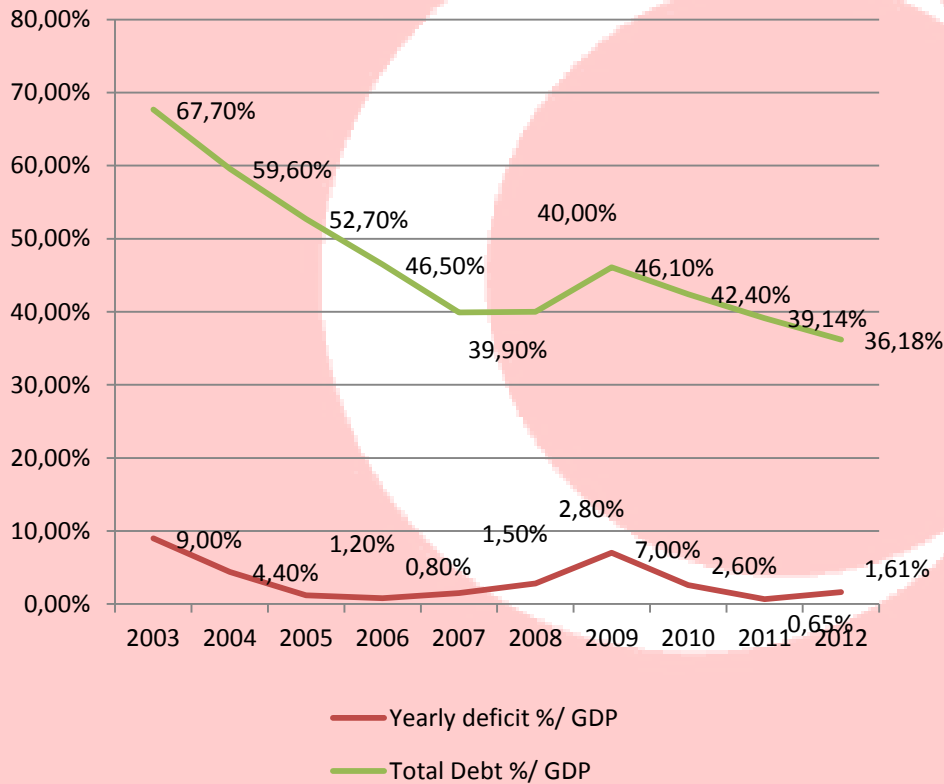
Nationalist Party in Turkey
